# WATER SMARTER WITH RAIN BARRELS





- · Help to control local flooding
- Recharge local groundwater resources
- Protect rivers and streams from erosion
- Keep pollutants from paved areas from entering waterways
- Help to reduce the need for sewer upgrades in combined sewer overflow communities
- Capture a valuable resource that would otherwise be lost to storm drains
- Divert stormwater back to the landscape

### RAIN BARREL REBATTE

### WEATHER-BASED IRRIGATION CONTROLLER:

A rebate up to \$100\* toward the price of purchase and installation of a controller system that adjusts the irrigation system's station run times based on lawn watering needs rather than on a preset, fixed schedule.

### **RAIN SENSOR:**

A rebate up to \$50\* toward the purchase and installation of a rain sensor that can interrupt the irrigation system during a rain event.

#### PROGRAMMABLE IRRIGATION TIMER:

A rebate up to \$75\* toward the purchase and installation of any irrigation timer that works with an underground irrigation system to comply with all City lawn watering schedules.

### RAIN BARREL:

A rebate up to \$50\* toward the purchase and installation of an enclosed device or system used for capturing precipitation from a building rooftop. Qualifying rain barrels must have a minimum capacity of 40 gallons and be designed for the intended purpose of rain capture.
