STOP THE SCAM!

Utility scams are on the rise. Scammers intimidate, threaten and manipulate their victims. Be aware of the following red flags:

A call demanding immediate payment over the phone. Sioux Valley Energy will never demand immediate payment. Members will have significant advance notice if their electric bill is past due.
