**June needs at the BAFP**

**Movie Night at McHardy Park**

Grab a blanket or your lawn chairs and head to McHardy Park for five Movie Nights this summer, starting Thursday, June 25. The family-friendly movie nights will offer fun and food with inflatables and local and area food vendors onsite starting at 8 p.m. The movie starts at dusk (9 p.m.)

The June 25 movie, "Sonic, the Hedgehog," is jointly sponsored by Hegg Realty-Harry Buck and the Brandon Valley Journal. "Sonic, the Hedgehog" is a 2020 action-adventure comedy film based on the video game franchise published by Sega. It stars Ben Schwartz as the voice of Sonic, the Hedgehog, and Jim Carrey as Doctor Robotnik, as well as James Marsden, Tika Sumpter, Natasha Rothwell, Adam Pally and Neal McDonough.

**July 4 Parade in Brandon**

In lieu of Brandon's annual Loyalty Day being trimmed down due to the coronavirus, Brandon Three Rivers VFW Post 4726 members are organizing a July 4 parade, which will step off at 1 p.m. from the Brandon

Valley High School parking lot. Anyone wanting to participate in the Independence Day celebration is encouraged to do so. Staging will begin at 12 noon.

The parade will be escorted by the Brandon Police Department west on Holly Boulevard. The route will not proceed down Main Avenue as usual because of road construction. Instead, the parade will continue to Holly Boulevard and units will disperse on North Robin Drive (road between Holly Crossing and Dollar General).

The VFW Auxiliary will have hotdogs and walking tacos for sale. The VFW will also be open for business that day.

**June needs at the BAFP**

June needs at the Brandon Area Food Pantry include bagged soups (i.e. Bear Creek, Shore Lunch), bottled juices, hard taco shells, taco meat seasoning, pancake mix and syrup, pizza crust mixes, cookie and muffin mixes, beef stew, canned ravioli and spaghetti, hand soap and disinfectant wipes.

To ensure health and well-being, shoppers and donors are no longer allowed inside the Pantry building. Instead, an assortment of pre-bagged canned foods, proteins, and paper goods (based on the size of family), is being dispersed.

The BAFP is open from 4-6

p.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays and will maintain those hours until further notice.

The BAFP continues to accept used eye glasses and hearing aids on behalf of the Brandon Lions Club.

**Brandon Library starts grab-n-go service**

The Brandon and Valley Springs Community Libraries are easing back into opening the doors to patrons. Starting Tuesday, June 16, the Brandon Library will be open 9 a.m. to 12 noon Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. The Valley Springs Library will be open 5-6:30 p.m. Thursdays.

Patrons are invited to visit the library to browse the collection, pick up requests and check out. Staff will be available to assist with library accounts and face masks are recommended. Seating, computers, play areas, meeting rooms and in-person programming is not available at this time.

To place reserve items, visit [siouxlandlib.org](http://siouxlandlib.org) or call 367-8700. Under the library's current procedures, when item(s) arrive, the patron will receive a notice via email, text, or phone with instructions.

Starting Monday, June 8, the Downtown Library in Sioux Falls will be open Monday-Friday 9 a.m.-1 p.m., and starting Monday, June 15, the Ronning Branch will be open Monday

through Friday 9 a.m.-1 p.m. and the Caille branch will be open 1-5 p.m. Monday-Friday.

**Current lawn watering restrictions**

The city of Brandon is in stage 1 (green) of lawn watering restrictions. The even/odd schedules allow users with even-numbered addresses to water on even-number calendar day; users with odd-numbered address are allowed to water on odd-numbered calendar dates.

Water restriction stages and other updates are posted on the city website and Facebook pages.

**Grab & Go Lunches continue through June**

Brandon Valley School District's Grab & Go Lunch program, which is available to all BV students, will continue to distribute daily lunches through June from 11 a.m.-12 noon on Tuesdays only. 
