



In lieu of Brandon's annual Loyalty Day being trimmed down due to the coronavirus, Brandon Three Rivers VFW Post 4726 members are organizing a July 4 parade, which will step off at 1 p.m. from the Brandon

Anyone wanting to participate the Independence Day celebration is encouraged to do so. Staging will begin at 12 noon.

The parade will be escorted by the Brandon Police Department west on Holly Boulevard. The route will not proceed down Main Avenue as usual because of road construction. Instead, the parade will continue to Holly Boulevard and units will disperse on North Robin Drive (road between Holly Crossing and Dollar General).

The VFW Auxiliary will have hotdogs and walking tacos for sale. The VFW will also be open for business that day.

The Brandon and Valley Springs Community Libraries are easing back into opening the doors to patrons. Starting Tuesday, June 16, the Brandon Library will be open 9 a.m. to 12 noon Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. The Valley Springs Library will be open 5-6:30 p.m. Thursdays.

Patrons are invited to visit the library to browse the collection, pick up requests and check out. Staff will be available to assist with library accounts and face masks are recommended. Seating, computers, play areas, meeting rooms and in-person programming is not available at this time.




